




YASHA Ministry

We (my wife Lydia and I with our 3 adopted kids) went to Kenya Sept 2001 to be lecturers at Njoro Bible College under the management of Africa Missions. In 2003 the desire we had to work among the unreached people in Kenya was fulfilled when we start working with the Dorobo tribe that mostly live in the Forest areas. The word Dorobo means poor people without cattle. Gods plan for us was to plant churches and to focus on equipping and training the leaders so that they can be able in impart what they received from God into their congregations. We were also involved with community projects such as water conservation, planting of trees as well as farming God's way on a small scale. Recently we also start with nursery schools where we have planted churches.

God gave us a heart for children and in 2004 we started with "Yasha Playgroup" in our garage to cater for the needs of the small children that was just wandering aimlessly in the streets without purpose. We started with 3 children and 2 babies, but it was not long when we reached our capacity and the need for a baby day care centre, nursery and primary school was confirmed. In 2004 Yasha Mission Academy was born "YASHA is a Hebrew root word that means that help or deliverance is freely and openly available to provide a haven of safety for every child".

God showed us that the children of single moms, widows and orphans that stayed with their extended families was on his heart and that He wants them to have an opportunity to have a good education. We make use of the ACE-School of Tomorrow program that put Jesus at the centre of everything. Our belief is that we want to prepare the children for life and not merely to pass an exam.

Yasha Mission Academy is the base from where we operate and we have babies from 4 months old up to grade 5. We have about 90 children and 20 staff and our hot lunch feeding program provides a hot meal for all students and staff-which for some is their only proper meal for the day. The three other nursery schools are satellite schools in the following areas- Teret, Mogotio (Muslim area) and Sugutek. The aim with the satellite schools is to teach the children to read, speak and write English before they start with primary education. The results is amazing – Praise be to God!

We also started in 2008 with a Yasha Guesthouse project as a local initiative to raise funds to support Yasha Mission Academy. Apart from being a Guesthouse we also convert it in 2012 into a boarding facility for streetkids that is now known as Yasha Hope Centre, helping and moulding and educating these children. We also started with Yasha Animal Sanctuary

and Awareness Centre, a project to bring awareness of wildlife and nature to the children and the community. Yasha Ministry faces some challenges and the most urgent one is that we have rented a big house with outside buildings, but it was sold on auction in 2011 and we were forced to shift the school to the land we are renting that form part of the Yasha Guesthouse compound. We have erected temporary buildings, but our desire is to buy the 13 acre land and to build the children of Njoro their very own school with adequate facilities.

This is just a brief introduction of what God is busy doing in Yasha and our desire is to see the full accomplishment of the original intent God had for us and the people in our community here in Njoro Kenya. If you need more information feel free to contact us
